

MSP Practitioner Seminar

Overview	The MSP Practitioner Seminar provides each participant with a Practitioner understanding of how to apply MSP in realistic project scenarios and adapt MSP to different programme environments
Course Objectives	By the end of the Practitioner Seminar delegates will be: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Able to describe and apply all facets of programme management, in accordance with the MSP method; • Know how to set up and manage complex programmes, tailoring MSP while ensuring effective integration of projects; • Monitor the objectives of a programme and make the essential adjustments needed to respond to changes in the environment; • Fully prepared for the Practitioner Exam.
Who Should Attend	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Experienced Programme Managers who need to be able to work effectively in an MSP environment; • Senior Project Managers wishing to move into programme management; • 'Centre of excellence' staff and strategy implementation planners who need a solid understanding of MSP to tailor the method for their organisations; • Project and programme support staff wanting to learn how to effectively operate in an MSP environment; • Anyone wishing to round out their resume with a formal internationally recognised project management certification.
Prerequisites	Participants must have previously completed the Foundation course. Delegates must have passed the Foundation exam to sit the Practitioner exam.
Course Content	<p>The course is scenario based, and focuses on the application of MSP under different programme environments and scenarios. Review and revision sessions of all MSP elements are included throughout the training. There will be homework each evening.</p> <p>The MSP Practitioner Exam is a 2½ hour, open manual, scenario based multiple choice exam. The exam consists of 80 questions across 8 syllabus areas presented in the following styles: Classical multiple choice; Yes/No; Multiple response; Matching; Sequencing; Assertion/Reason. The candidate must correctly answer 55% or more of the questions to pass the exam. Candidates for the Practitioner Exam must have passed the Foundation Exam. We conduct the exams on behalf of APMG.</p>
Included with the course	Practitioner Delegate Workbook including activities and sample exams; Practitioner Exam; Lunch, and morning and afternoon refreshments; Post-course support, including access to our alumni-only resources.
Delivery	Public or in-house classroom-style over 2 days. eLearning and blended offerings coming.
